
CHALLENGES

Grant Writing and Grant Funding

DO

- Create a 'primary' grant application document.
- Try to speak with a program officer first
- Follow the directions answer the questions!
- Be clear, concise and compelling
- Try to include testimonials
- Apply for multi-year grants when possible

DON'T

- Try to fit a square peg in a round hole
- Think you have to do it yourself
- Assume the reviewer will understand your acronyms
- Forget about ALL of the costs of your program
- Wait until the last minute
- Frame the proposal in term of your organization's needs

Individual Fundraising

Process: The Development Continuum

Ignorance → Awareness → Interest → Participation → Commitment → Ownership

Goal: Realize to the fullest extent possible the potential value of the donor over the course of his/her lifetime.

Strategy: Work to sustain donor relations over time by moving them as far along the development continuum as possible.

Method: Provide ongoing education, nurture direct personal involvement, and provide highly personalized quality services that continually exceed donor expectations.

Integrating Marketing and Communications

- Create an editorial calendar. Keep control!
- Talk to the program team all the time.
- What type of content? Story Arc. Beginning/Middle/End.
- What style of content? Long form/Short form/Visual form. Re-purpose.
- Who are you talking to?
- Keep it simple. Always state the need.
